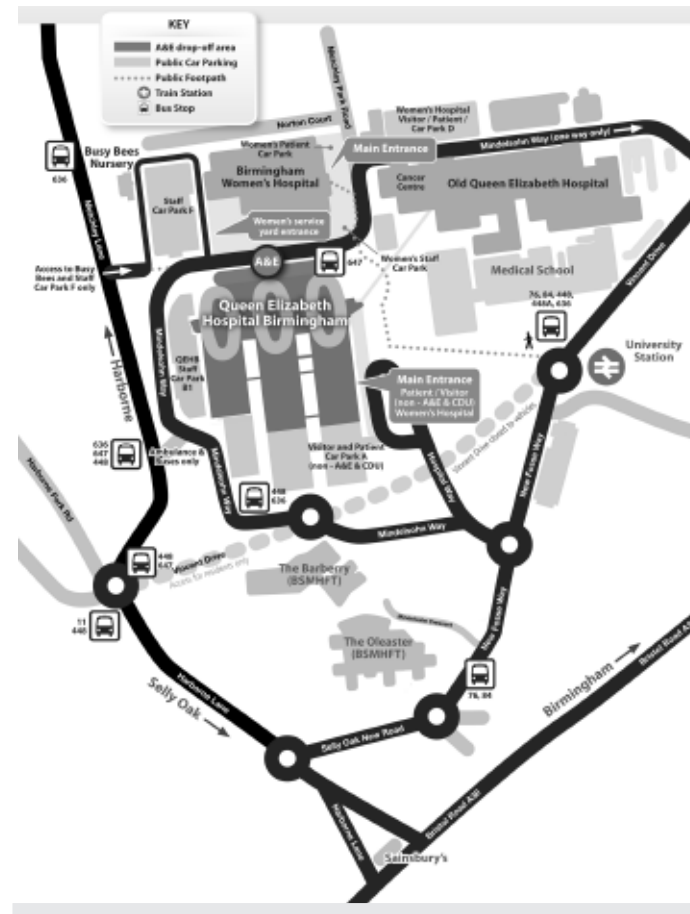

### What is an amenity bed?

An amenity bed is available to NHS patients who wish to pay for the privacy of a single room whilst their treatment remains on the NHS. Birmingham Women's Hospital offers a limited number of single rooms (some with en-suite facilities) to patients who wish to pay for this facility. These are available on Ward 1 (Ante-natal Ward) and Wards 3 & 4 (Post-natal Wards)

### Can I pre-book an amenity bed?

No, amenity beds are subject to availability and during periods of high occupancy on the wards or clinical requirements, single rooms are not always available. If you wish to stay in a single room, please ask the ward or midwifery staff caring for you during your stay if an amenity bed is available and we will do our best to facilitate this for you.

### How much does it cost and how do I pay?

An amenity bed costs £78 for a standard single room and £227 for a single room with en-suite bathroom. No other facilities are included in this charge. We will invoice you once you have returned home for each night you have stayed in an amenity bed.

Payment can be made by cheque or by credit card (there is a phone number for card payments). You will be required to complete the form on the right should you wish to purchase an amenity bed.

***Please note you will not be charged for use of these rooms unless you specifically requested a single room.***
