Our aim is to ensure a smooth
transition from hospital to home for
babies who have required specialist
care from birth.



We are based at the Birmingham Women's Hospital NHS Foundation Trust.

The team consists of Registered Midwives and Registered Sick Children's Nurses. All are qualified in the speciality of Neonatal Care.

We routinely see all babies who live within the South Birmingham PCT, who fit the community neonatal service criteria.

We care for both mother and baby:

- a. Providing a complete check on babies growth, health and well being.
- b. Postnatal care for up to 28 days or when fit for discharge.

We provide a Monday—Friday service and aim to visit within the first few days following discharge.

The team act as referral agents for problems and concerns that are identified.

At discharge we will transfer the care of your baby/babies to the Health Visitor and GP.
